In addition to its full concert season, Symphony in C oversees a substantial music education outreach program, ***Music Matters!***, that reaches over 5,000 children and youth annually, primarily in underserved areas such as Camden and North Philadelphia. **All proceeds from Serenade on the River will go toward funding these programs, which consist of *Classroom Symphony, Symphony Summer Camp, Concerts for Young People, Master Classes, and After-School Music Lessons.***
